- Growth of strong trusts (10 schools/7,500 pupils)

Applications from CE Voluntary Aided schools

Consent will only be considered for applications to join with an overall CE majority (ie a VA model).

Applications from CE Voluntary Controlled/Foundation schools

Consent will only be considered for applications to join:

- An academy trust with an overall CE majority; OR
- An academy trust with 25% CE minority trusteeship (eg a VC model); OR
- A 'community based' multi-academy trust (MAT) that was prepared to reconstitute to a 25% CE minority trusteeship and foundation guarantees in the Articles of Association.


CONTINUED

Applications from CE/Methodist or other joint denominational Voluntary Controlled schools

Consent will only be considered for applications to join:

- An academy trust with an overall CE or Methodist majority; OR
- An academy trust with 25% CE minority trusteeship (eg a VC model); OR
- A 'community based' multi-academy trust (MAT) that was prepared to reconstitute to a 25% CE minority trusteeship and foundation guarantees in the Articles of Association.

Update on Education Investment Areas, and Priority Areas



7 of the 10 Greater Manchester areas are Education Investment Areas (Bolton, Bury, Rochdale, Manchester, Oldham, Salford, Tameside)

4 of these 7 areas are Priority Areas (Rochdale, Tameside, Oldham, Salford)



MDBE STRATEGY: SCHOOLS

- Framework regarding options, not prescriptive
- Recognises importance of local links, partnerships valued
- Applies to all schools
- Recommended list of CE MATs
- MDBE policy consistently applied
- EIAs, PAs & RSC
- Governance protections in line with MoU
- Local hub model encouraged

MDBE STRATEGY: MATS

- MATs across LAs
- Open to all schools
- Welcome to community schools
- Diocesan/MC/PCC representation at Member/trustee/LGB level
- Diocesan training regarding sustaining & developing Christian distinctiveness
- Growth of current MATs

Process

- Inform DBE/RD of initial interest
- Explore MATs
- Due diligence
- Consult
- Apply for MDBE permission
- Apply for Regional Director's permission

Process to academisation

Information required:

- School capital & revue for 3 years
- Any loans/leases
- Projected pupil numbers for 3 years
- School building information
- Land ownership information
- Consultation information

Evidence required

- Resolution passed by GB
- Letter from MAT hoping to join
- MDBE letter of consent
- Letter of consent from Foundation trust (if appropriate)
