

I. A Card Reader Machine







How can I benefit from GASDS & Gift aid?

- Being able to uplift your donations by GASDS (the Gift Aid Small Donations Scheme) or Gift Aid will add 25% to the amount donated
- In April 2017 the government changed the rules on GASDS so that contactless donations can now be counted in your GASDS allocation
- To claim GASDS ideally the contactless terminal should be linked to your donations system so that the donations are automatically imported, marked as GASDS and included in your next claim without any extra work
- To claim Gift Aid on Contactless donations you will need a donations system that works with the contactless terminal and so that it can match a donation to a specific donor record and thus potentially enable Gift aid to be claimed



Tap and Go contactless terminal

Data Developments supply a contactless terminal which is portable, doesn't require it to be connected to a phone socket, a power supply (it can run from a battery) or WiFi.

Simply enter the Terminal ID number in to our online donations system called MyGiving.Online and this will link the contactless terminal to your MyGiving Church account.





My <u>iving.Online</u>

- Donations are automatically transferred into MyGiving. Online ready to be included in any upcoming claim as part of your GASDS allocation.
- One of a kind token routine enables you to claim Gift Aid on donations received from known donors.
- A scheduling facility identifies donations received on a certain day and time as belonging to individual churches, enabling a single device to be used across multiple locations.


