2. Role Purpose

General

- i. To exercise the cure of souls shared with the bishop in this benefice in collaboration with your colleagues, in particular a Pioneer Team Vicar
- ii. To have regard to the calling and responsibilities of the clergy as described in the Canons, the Ordinal, the Code of Professional Conduct for the Clergy, and other relevant legislation.

4. Role context and any other relevant information.

The ATMC Team comprises three parishes which cover the old 'Tyldesley Urban District Council' area, and since 1974 has been part of Wigan Council. It is steeped in history from farming and early industry in the form of cottage spinning and weaving. Its past is framed by early industrialization powered by

the growth of deep level coal mining. In the 21st century there are strong transport links and easy access to the countryside and local attractions. The benefice has opportunities to work with estate communities as well as more suburban communities. There is an interim Team Vicar, a Pioneer Minister working on the Shackerley Estate and a team of other lay and ordained leaders. There is a modern 4-bedroom house for use by the successful candidate.
